

On the Day of Your Five Rivers Visit



AT SCHOOL:

- 🍁 Make sure students are wearing their name tags and are divided into groups of 15 or less.
- 🍁 Have any medical supplies (for allergies, asthma, etc.) ready to go with the child's group.
- 🍁 Use the restrooms at your school before boarding the bus.

CHECK-IN at FIVE RIVERS:

- 🍁 Arrive promptly at the scheduled check-in time. Please note that this is 15 minutes before your class is to begin. This allows time for you to meet with the Program Coordinator to finalize your trip.
- 🍁 Drive to Goose Lodge where the Program Coordinator will greet you and assign instructors. Goose Lodge is the building at the far end of the parking lot, past the Visitor Center.
 - If you are coming by car, please park in the parking lot and gather your group on the lawn.
 - If you are arriving by bus, please use the bus entrance and the Program Coordinator will direct you to a parking space.

VISITOR GUIDELINES:

Please discuss these with your class prior to your visit.

- 🍁 Five Rivers is a nature sanctuary. We will respect all parts of the environment during your visit, especially when examining and handling plants and wildlife. When your lesson is finished, please continue in this spirit. Do not disturb wildlife or pick/collect any items here at Five Rivers.
- 🍁 Smoking and littering are strictly prohibited.
- 🍁 Use caution when crossing the parking lot or nearby roads.
- 🍁 Enjoy the natural setting of Five Rivers; bearing in mind others are here doing the same.

AFTER THE LESSON:

- 🍁 All groups are welcome to visit our hands-on exhibits and bird watching area in the Visitor Center!
- 🍁 Stay and have lunch outside if you like. In inclement weather, your group may use our indoor area to eat **IF** it is available. You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks as we do not have drinking fountains or a snack bar. We are a carry in/carry out facility. Recycle what you can!
